■ he General Contractor, David Mandel of Triple J&R Inc. indicated to the tenants that the construction would last 2+ years.

Construction Would

Create nightmarish living conditions and possibly drive out residents of 85 Eastern Parkway.

Create quality of life interruptions both short and long term: Noise, vibrations, dust, loss of light and views, water, gas and electrical shutdowns, more competition for parking.

Involve heavy equipment, scaffolding, cranes and a sidewalk bridge.

Create continual disruptions and will interfere with service road access, sidewalk access and parking.

Permanently change the skyline.

Environmental & Safety Hazards: Construction could undermine the foundations of 85 Eastern Parkway and adjoining buildings 77 & 95 Eastern Parkway as well as 362 Lincoln Place, create fire safety issues for original and adjoining buildings.
